1 PROPOSED BOND ISSUE WEIRD FUN

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall bonds be issued by the City of Cincinnati for the purpose of **PAYING THE LOCAL SHARE OF WEIRD UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO INTERESTINGNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND THE COST OF OTHER IMPROVEMENTS TO CITY INFRASTRUCTURE TO FACILITATE WEIRDNESS, TOGETHER WITH, AS APPLICABLE, NEW PERFORMANCE EVENTS, CULTURAL EVENTS, NONSENSICAL CONSTRUCTIONS, RENOVATIONS, AND OTHER ADDITIONS TO EXISTING INFRASTRUCTURE, AS WELL AS COSTUMES, EPHEMERAL ART HAPPENINGS, PUBLIC ROCK CONCERTS, LARGE & SMALL SIGNS, TEMPORARY INSTALLATIONS, CONFUSING & UNNECESSARY FESTIVALS, AFFORDABLE ART OBJECTS AND ALL APPURTENANCES THEREFOR, AND CAPITALIZED INTEREST (IF ANY)**, in the principal amount of \$76,663,462 to be repaid annually over a maximum period of thirty-seven (37) years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue eight and forty-eight hundredths (8.48) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to eighty-four and eight-tenths cents (\$0.848) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2014, first due in calendar year 2015, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

3 PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL) CINCINNATI ARTS & CULTURE

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the City of Cincinnati, County of Hamilton, Ohio, for the purpose of **EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS**, in the sum of \$65,178,000 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average ten and twenty-six hundredths (10.26) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to one dollar and two and six-tenths cents (\$1.026) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2015, first due in calendar year 2016?

4 PROPOSED TAX LEVY DOWNTOWN SUMMER WATERSLIDE

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

An additional tax for the benefit of the Cincinnati, County of Hamilton, Ohio, for the purpose of **CONSTRUCTION & FUTURE OPERATING EXPENSES OF WATERSLIDE SUMMER PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION** at a rate not exceeding five and ninety-five hundredths (5.95) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty-nine and five-tenths cents (\$0.595) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2014, first due in calendar year 2015.
